



ABOUT THIS COFFEE

We share FAF Coffees' vision that true sustainability includes minimising waste.

As the speciality coffee industry has developed, it has been the larger beans that have been sought. For the farmers, they represent 40 to 50% of their total production, not even half!

Our partner FAF has created this Mirim project to recycle the smaller beans (14/15) from the Bob-o-link project. Their SCA score ranges from 83 to 84.25, and they contain 8 to 16 defects. Adding value to these quality coffees at a more competitive price offers incredible potential for new opportunities for speciality coffee (local shops, company offices, small supermarkets, etc.).

The beans from sieves 14 and 15 represent 15 to 25% of their production.
