ABOUT THIS COFFEE

Originating from the botanical garden of Coffea Diversa, this lot highlights the Bourbon Pointu variety, also known as Laurina Pointed, a rare coffee with a distinctive genetic heritage.

Coffea Diversa is a pioneering project founded in the early 2000s by José Padilla and Gonzalo Hernández, driven by a radically different vision of traditional coffee farming. Designed as a coffee botanical garden, the project focuses on preserving, observing, and showcasing coffee's genetic diversity through the cultivation of hundreds of rare botanical varieties. Today, Coffea Diversa hosts the world's largest private collection of coffee botanical varieties, with more than 800 specimens, only a portion of which are currently produced as micro-lots.

Bourbon Pointu originated in the mid-19th century on Bourbon Island, now known as La Réunion.
