ABOUT THIS COFFEE

Wadessa coffee is harvested in the Dambi Uddo forest, characterised by an exceptional ecological diversity with many different tree species. The wadessa, after which this coffee is named, is a slow-growing tree that can reach up to 25 metres in height and offers a shade well-suited to coffee trees. The natural coffee produced here offers notes of peach, mango and sweet orange. By promoting this forest coffee, our teams hope to preserve the unique Dambi Uddo agroforestry model, in which coffee trees play an essential role.
