ABOUT THIS COFFEE

This coffee is produced in India's Western Ghats, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, thanks to the region's rich biodiversity. Hoysala is a farm built in 1889. It has been in the same family since 1950 and is now run by the 4th generation. Each year, it produces 10,000 bags of coffee, both arabica and robusta.

The farm is located 20 km from the nearest town, Mudigere, in the Chikkamagaluru district of Karnataka state. The coffees are produced under shade using regenerative and environmentally-friendly farming practices. Walking among the coffee trees, you'll discover a rich diversity: firstly of coffees, with arabicas and robustas, but also of fruits & different spices: black pepper, areca nuts, cardamom. Within this canopy, there are over 200 species of animals (birds, insects and reptiles).
