Aman Adinew founded Metad in 2010, and coffee production began three years later. His brother, Tariku Adinew, joined the company shortly afterward. In Hambela, Metad owns a 200-hectare farm located in the Hambela Wamenna woreda, specifically in the Alaka and Bishan Fugu kebeles.

This Guji forest coffee is offered by Metad. Committed to restoring the full value and recognition of this type of production, they promote from the village of Bishan Fugu a carefully traced, hand-harvested forest coffee, known for its distinctive fruity profile.

The farming system used on these plots follows Ethiopia's well-known semi-forest model.
