It is exported by the family business ASK, run by Nadja Sofian. Determined and passionate about coffee, Nadja Sofian continues her family's work.

The Nibret Alimu washing station, still in the Sidama region, takes the name of its current owner. Hundreds of producers come here to drop off their coffee cherries, which are then washed and dried at this facility, which has 18 washing basins and over 100 drying beds.

The station is located at an altitude of 1,850 m, in the woreda (district) of Chiré, in the village of Kuburta.
