ABOUT THIS COFFEE

Sourced from the Puntang area in the Sunda terroir of West Java, this coffee is a blend of Typica, Line S, and Catimor.

This coffee is grown exclusively under the shade of various tree species (pine, eucalyptus, erythrina, avocado). It is processed as a semi-washed coffee by the Klasik Beans cooperative, which also operates on the islands of Bali, Java, Sunda, Flores, and Sulawesi.

Founded in 2008 by a group of producers in Puntang, the Klasik Beans cooperative shares a philosophy complementary to Belco's, whether in terms of quality, human values, or respect for the environment.

Set between high-altitude forest and rice paddies, the plantations span the Guntur, Halimu Tilu, and Puntang volcanoes. With each harvest, coffee cherries are hand-picked and brought to one of the cooperative's 3 processing sites (Pacet, Ciwidey, or Garut). The cooperative works with over 200 producers.
