



ABOUT THIS COFFEE

Antonio is the fourth generation of producers in his family. He inherited the farm in 1993 and now produces coffee on 10 hectares. The total area of the farm is 60 hectares and it is named "La Laguna" because there are many natural springs including a lagoon. The coffee trees grow under the shade of a cypress forest.

Antonio is currently carrying out many projects on his farm such as

- 1 - Soil analysis to produce in a healthy and sustainable way and increase quality and yield
- 2 - Renovating his African beds to improve the quality of his drying
- 3 - Developing and testing new processes such as anaerobic fermentation for the next harvest
- 4 - Plant 3 more manzanas (2 hectares) on his farm with Pacamara and Geisha varieties.
