ABOUT THIS COFFEE

Finca Las Isabellas is a farm located in Apaneca, Ahuachapán, El Salvador, at an altitude ranging from 900 to 1,340 meters above sea level. The farm has been owned by Emilio Lopez since 2007. With a total area of 245 hectares, 87 hectares are now a natural reserve that shelters endangered endemic species and serves as a water source for neighboring communities. The farm currently produces the varieties Pacamara, Pacas, and Red Bourbon.

We have been partners with Odyssey Coffees for ten years, a project led by Emilio López in El Salvador. As a producer, Emilio manages six farms: La Cumbre, El Manzano, Ayutepeque, Las Isabellas, Tapantogusto, and Las Piedras. Odyssey's values are based on the long-term sustainability of their farms, surrounding communities, and the environment.

With this in mind, Emilio López is committed to building state-of-the-art facilities, providing optimal working conditions for his team, and certifying his farms with Rainforest Alliance to ensure compliance with high social, environmental, and quality standards.
